

It is your responsibility to safely and securely anchor the greenhouse, having regard to the windiest conditions in the area.

CHECK PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLY. All parts have been labeled well, please sort, separate and identify all parts and hardware before construction, and check against the Parts List in this manual.

REQUIRED TOOLS

Bellow tools are required for the erection of the greenhouse. These tools should be at hand before starting work:

- 1 Screw driver
- 2. Spanner (the aperture is 8mm)
- 3. Measuring tape
- 4.Silicon glue
- 5.Gloves

NOTE: The warnings, precautions, and instructions discussed in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur.







P- Remove approximately 2 inches of film from all sheet edges before installing, and remove all film immediately after the construction is completed.


P- Please note the side with the sticker of "THIS SIDE FACE THE SUN" must face towards the sun.












































